Harman - Minimum passenger number is 15 (groups of fewer than 15 pay for 15 passengers). Maximum passenger number is 22.

Berrima - Maximum passenger number is 14.

Lady Hopetoun - Maximum passenger number is 27

A \$200 deposit as well as a signed copy of the Vessel Hire Agreement is required to secure a group's booking and confirm its acceptance of the Sydney Heritage Fleet (SHF) Terms & Conditions for the booked cruise. **The balance of payment is due on or before the cruise date.**

The cruise **Up the Lazy River** is subject to the availability of the Newington Armoury Pontoon. If the pontoon is unavailable an altered cruise route can be offered.

The cruise can take place in almost all-weather conditions. The scheduled cruise may, however, be postponed by the SHF at any time, even on the scheduled cruise day, if there are safety, mechanical, operational or passenger comfort issues or concerns. In these rare circumstances, contact will be made with the group leader and a raincheck issued for another day or a full refund of monies paid will be made only if a raincheck is not feasible.

If the cruise is postponed or cancelled for any reason by the group within 7 working days of the scheduled departure time, the deposit paid will be forfeited.

PLEASE NOTE

- SHF regrets that these cruises are not wheelchair accessible and that the *Harman / Berrima* are unable to carry / store walkers.
- Groups should note that these cruises require a reasonable level of mobility with some walking involved. Passengers will be required to use a small ramp and several stairs to embark and disembark. **Please contact the SHF Office to discuss any issues regarding passenger mobility.**
- **Passengers must wear sturdy covered footwear.** Stilettoes and sharp heels are prohibited. Open-toed footwear is not allowed on cruise that visit the SHF Heritage Docks and Workshop at Rozelle as it is an industrial construction site.
- Passengers are advised to bring a bottle of water and on hot days a sunhat that won't blow off. On cool or forecast wet days we advise that you bring a lightweight jacket or rainwear.
- **Meeting Point:** Two big anchors at the Australian National Maritime Museum, 2 Murray Street, Pyrmont at 09:45am sharp.
- Lunch is not included in the *Harman* or *Berrima* group booking price. A complementary morning tea is included on Lady Hopetoun Cruises.
- There is no toilet for passenger use on board *Harman* or *Berrima*.
